- FBI relocation to Prince Georges County-A decision has not been made regarding the relocation of the FBI.

- Fish Fry – A discussion of the pricing of items for the fish fry took place during the meeting. All members present agreed that the details would be discussed at a separate executive board meeting.

- No dumpsters will be delivered this year.
- A letter will be sent out requesting that each house in the community pay \$10 for mosquito control.
- We will report the low level of water in the Maryland Wetlands to DPWT or whoever the Gov agency is that can resolve the issue.
- Delegate Healy advised on who to contact regarding the signs that are being posted in the center median of our local roads. VP Stephanie Hicks will follow up on the issue
- Mrs. Anderson sent a list to MNCPPC of Community Building concerns to Mrs. Ramos, including programs we can have at our center. Lights in the parking lot, etc.
- Marching through Time @ Marietta Mansion will be held on April 18 & 19, 2015. The cost is \$5 per person.
- The Planning Board has re-approved the Wal-Mart site application-In the Appeal Stage.
