2020 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION DATES

General Election - November 3, 2020 from 7 am until 8 pm.

Early Voting for the General Election - Thursday, October 22, 2020 through Thursday, October 29, 2020 from 8 am until 8 pm.

Senator Pinsky and Senator Bill Ferguson both called for a vote-by-mail election in November. The senators asked for more polling places, more drop boxes, and modified early voting to expand voting access as we continue to deal with the pandemic. During the primary election in June, the polling and drop box locations had very long lines because there were not enough of them. Expanding the locations would correct this issue. The decision now lies with Governor Hogan. The PG County Board of Elections is open by appointment only now. Please call (301) 341-7300 to make an appointment. 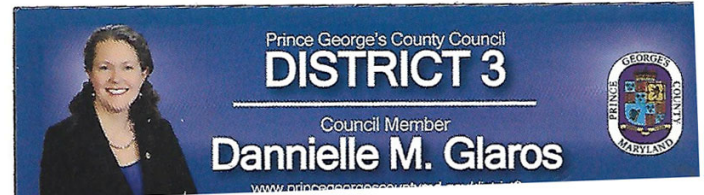

Baltimore Lane, Center-Maryland Avenue and Hiland Avenue

Guidelines for Dumpster Use (THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED)

Landscaping materials such as rocks, dirt, concrete and blacktop cannot be placed in the dumpsters.

Never leave materials on the ground next to the dumpsters

Never fill the dumpster above the sidewalls.

Hazardous and bio-hazardous medical waste

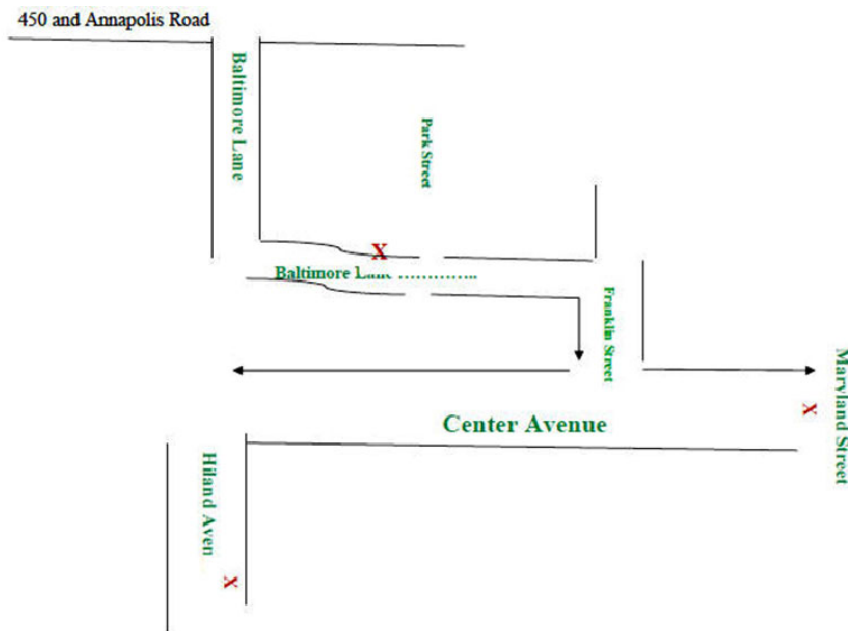
Automobiles or auto parts

Chemical and/or petroleum cleanup waste

Compressed cylinders of any size, shape or condition

Drums, tanks, kegs and barrels (plastic and metal* Fencing/sheds/gazebos

Glass



SAFETY FIRST: Keep your phone with you when out in the yard. You never know when an emergency may occur. Having a phone nearby allows you to call a neighbor, fire department, or police in short time. It's a safeguard for you and your neighbors. Also, remember to lock car, home, and garage doors. Do not store valuables in the car. Keep entry ways visible and open from obstruction and Lights ON!!
